



2021 'THE BOND CUP'

Conditions of Competition

MATCH PLAY ROUNDS:

Men: The Man's Playing Handicap will be 100 % of his calculated **COURSE** Handicap.

Ladies: The Ladies' Playing Handicap will be 100% of her calculated **COURSE** Handicap PLUS 1.0 Stroke.

The Player with the higher Playing Handicap will then receive the FULL DIFFERENCE between the two Playing Handicaps.

TEEING GROUND: Men play from the MENS WHITES, Ladies from the LADIES REDS.

STROKE INDEX:

N.B., In all Match Play rounds both Men and Ladies will take their Stroke allowances by reference to the **MEN'S S.I.**, as published on the scorecard, *except when two Ladies compete together in any Match*, including the Final, in which case the Ladies' S.I. would be used.

TIE RESOLUTION IN MATCH PLAY ROUNDS:

When any Match is tied after 18 holes, or after 36 holes of the Final Match, play will continue on a 'sudden death, hole by hole' basis , with play re-commencing from the 1st Teeing Ground, until a Winner is determined.
